

Weekly Family Worship Dec. 7, 2014

Theme: Pride

Our Point: Sinful pride is a path to destruction.

Read — Listen to God: 1 Kings 12:1-24, 14:21-31

Solomon's great wisdom did not keep him from foolish choices that led to idolatry and division for his people. The result was a divided, diminished pair of kingdoms: Israel in the north, and Judah in the south. As we will see, poor decisions fueled by pride carry a high price tag, both then and now.

Worship — Praise to God.

You may go to YouTube.com, use a CD, or choose a different song.

Do — Walk with God.

Option 1: Ask your children what they would do if they could be in charge. What kinds of rules would they instate? Would they make up silly rules? Would they be kind and fair? Allow your children to act out how they would rule. When everyone has had a turn, compare your actions to King Rehoboam's actions. Were you acting prideful? Would the light of Christ shine through your reign? Ponder these questions with your family.

Option 2: Ask your family the following questions:

- What are some examples of small, even insignificant choices that can lead to serious consequences?
- Why do people make poor choices such as these?
- What should we do when we realize we have made a poor choice?

Pray — Talk to God.

Rehoboam received conflicting advice from two different sources, and chose to go with the one that appealed more to him, the answer he wanted to hear. Pray that God would give you the wisdom to accept godly advice, instead of following your own prideful desires.

Preschool

Today your child learned an angel visited Mary to tell her she had been chosen by God to have baby Jesus, God's Son. Mary was engaged to Joseph. After they were married, they went to Bethlehem. There were many people there so they spent the night in a stable. That night, baby Jesus was born. Jesus Is a Gift of Love. Your child also began learning 2 Corinthians 9:15.

Elementary

Youth

Teens discussed how pride affects the life of the believer and creates a barrier between them and God. Make sure your teen received *Forward* student magazine and your parent newsletter, *What's Up?* Talk about why unity matters.
