Know: The Holy Spirit comforts, corrects, guides, teaches, and empowers us.

Think: The Holy Spirit lives in us and helps us live for Christ.

Do: Trust and follow the Holy Spirit's leading in your life.

Read—John 14:15-27; 15:26-27.

The Spirit of truth within us provides an internal testimony to the truth about Jesus. The Spirit points us to Christ and helps us live for Him and share the great news about Him.

Worship — Praise to God.

Do—Walk With God

Option 1: Allow your child to help you with a task around the house—like cooking supper or cleaning the living room. Encourage your child, letting him or her know that he or she is being such a good helper. Explain to your child that if he or she follows Jesus, he or she has the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is always there to help us. He wants to comfort us, encourage us, and help us make good choices.

Option 2: Ask your family to describe experiences in which they (or someone they know) had some special news that they could not keep to themselves. What was the news? Examples would be a young woman who has just become engaged, or a really good grade on a test (for your younger family members). Why do we feel compelled to share this kind of news? What would we think about an engagement where the bride-to-be is all excited, and the groom-to-be displays an attitude of “yeah, whatever”?

Pray—Talk to God

The Holy Spirit points people to Christ, and helps believers share the truth about Him with others. Is there someone in your life who needs to hear the truth about God? Pray that the Holy Spirit would lead you in sharing with this person.
