Know: The church helps us grow closer to God.

Think: Our thoughts, words, and actions should honor Christ.

Do: We are to honor Christ because He is worthy of our worship.

Read—Acts 2:1-47

In this passage, we see how the church was born, and how they started carrying out the purposes and characteristics of the risen Lord.

Worship — Praise to God.

Worthy of Worship— Hymn

Do—Walk With God

Option 1: Talk about going to church with your family. What are some of the things they like about church? What are some of their favorite songs to sing at church? What are some of their favorite things they have learned at church? Talk about why it's important that we go to church. It's good to have other people around us who are trying to love God the same way we are. It's good to have pastors who help guide us and help us learn more about God and His Word.

Option 2: Look at pictures of each of your children, and decide which parent each child favors the most. Ask your family: In what ways do we all look alike? How do we look different? What are some other ways you are like us?

Pray—Talk to God

The church is the fellowship of believers who are empowered by the Holy Spirit to spread the good news of Jesus Christ. What needs does your local church have? Pray that God would meet those needs and help your church be a godly influence in your community.

Preschool

Today your child learned Jesus met two fishermen, Peter and Andrew. Jesus told them to come follow Him and they would fish for men. Jesus wanted them to tell others to follow Jesus too. Peter and Andrew followed Jesus. I Can Follow Jesus too.

Elementary

Your student learned after Jesus' resurrection and before His ascension, He appeared to the disciples. He gave them the mission to share with everyone the truth that Jesus died for them. The followers of Jesus came together to form the early church. Together with the disciples, they worshiped, prayed, shared meals, shared their belongings, and praised God.

Youth

Teens discussed the role of the church and the importance of being involved in its work. Talk with your teen about ways he or she can be involved in the work of your local church.
