

Weekly Family Worship January 10, 2016

Know: God flooded the earth, but spared Noah, his family, and the animals in the ark.

Think: God is gracious, loving, and merciful.

Do: Follow Noah's example, and demonstrate

faith and obedience to God.

Read—Genesis 7:11—8:22

Grace and judgment seem to be strange bedfellows. We would not expect to see them in the same event. However, God brought both grace and judgment through a great flood.

Do-Walk With God

Option 1: Role-play a courtroom scene with your family. Choose someone to be the guilty party, someone to be the lawyer, etc. Save the role of judge for yourself. In each scenario, show the guilty party grace. Explain to your family that grace is getting something from God that we do not deserve. Talk about Noah and the flood. God flooded the whole earth because everyone had become very wicked. God had to give out judgment. God showed grace, though, when He saved Noah and his family. Sometimes it is hard for us to give grace like God does. Thank God for all the times He has shown you grace.

Option 2: Ask your family members to share any experience they have had with flooding. What was the situation? How bad was it? What damage was done? What was involved in the cleanup and repair?

Pray—Talk to God

Even in the darkest of days, we can be sure that God remembers His children. Thank God for the promises He has kept to you, and thank Him for the promises He will keep in the future.

This week in Sunday School...

Preschool

Today your child learned Noah brought his family along with two of every animal onto the ark. God caused it to rain for 40 days and 40 nights. Because Noah had obeyed God, everyone on the ark was safe. I Can Obey God, because He cares for me.

Elementary

Your student learned it rained for 40 days and 40 nights, and the ark floated for months before the water began to go down. When it was finally safe to leave the ark, Noah built an altar as an act of praise to the God who had saved them. God gave a rainbow as a promise that He would never destroy the earth again through a flood.

Youth

Teens studied how God is able to show grace and protection to His people in impossible circumstances. Talk to your teens about ways God has shown grace to you and your family. Spend some time together praising Him for these examples.
