Do—Walk With God

Option 1: Talk about different languages with your family. Talk about how hard it was to learn another language, if you can speak another language. Consider teaching your family how to count to ten in another language. Look up videos of different people speaking in different languages. Talk to your family about the tower of Babel. Before the people built the tower, everyone spoke the same language. The people were supposed to spread out on the earth, but they ignored what God told them. God confused their languages so they would move to different places on the earth.

Option 2: Set a timer for three minutes and see which family member can build the most impressive Lego tower. When time is up, have a vote on which tower is the best. The judging criteria can include heights, looks, stability, etc.
