Know: God made a covenant with Abraham to bless all the families of the earth through him.

Think: God is faithful to keep His promises.

Do: Trust God's goodness and presence in your life, and know He always keeps His promises.

Read—Genesis 12:1-9; 15:1-6

A lot of promises are made in our society, some we believe, and some we do not. In this passage we see what God promised to Abraham, and how Abraham responded to those promises.

Do—Walk With God

Option 1: Make your child a promise—such as going to get ice cream one Saturday, or making your child's favorite meal—and then be sure to keep that promise. Talk about God's promises. Sometimes, people don't keep their promises, but God always keeps His promises. The Bible is full of promises that God has kept. We can always trust that He will do what He says He is going to do. Say a prayer of thanks with your family, thanking God for keeping His promises.

Option 2: Ask your family to share various promises people make to each other. Why do people sometimes fail to keep their promises? What are some examples of people's broken promises? What are some examples of people keeping their promises?

Pray—Talk to God

We can rejoice that through the blessing of Abraham, all people on earth continue to be blessed. Say a prayer of thanksgiving for all of God's blessings.
