Know: Abraham trusted and obeyed God, and God provided a ram to be used for a sacrifice.

Think: God gives us grace.

Do: Choose to obey God with a good attitude.

Read—Genesis 22:1-19

Each of us has items or possessions that carry great value for us. If we were called to give them up, we would consider it a great sacrifice. In this passage, we see how God called Abraham to sacrifice the most important thing in the world to him, and how he responded.

Do—Walk With God

Option 1: Have you ever had a situation in life where God said, “Trust me”? Have you ever had a time when God seemingly stepped in at the last minute and provided? If so, share these stories with your family. Talk about how you felt trusting God when it seemed like He wasn’t going to come through. Explain to your family that we can always trust that God is taking care of us. He may not answer our prayers in the way we would expect, but He does always answer and provide.

Option 2: Have your family members show one of their most prized possessions. It could be a picture, a letter, jewelry, an antique, etc. Have a time of show and tell. Allow your family members to share why this object is so important. Make sure that everyone understands these are prized possessions and carry great intrinsic value.

Pray—Talk to God

God tests our faith to stretch and strengthen it for our benefit. In what ways is God stretching you? Thank Him for allowing you the opportunity to grow in faith. Ask that He would help you remain strong through whatever trial you may be facing.

Preschool

Today your child learned Jesus wants all people to know how much He cares and loves them. Some people have never heard of Jesus. They live in areas of the world where Bibles aren’t in the languages they read, write, and speak. We can tell others how much He cares for them and that Jesus Loves Everyone.

Elementary

Your student learned God told Abraham to take his only son, Isaac, to the mountains and offer him as a sacrifice. Abraham trusted God and he built an altar. Abraham was about to slay Isaac on it, when he heard God call out to him. God showed Abraham the ram that was to be the sacrifice for Isaac.

Youth

Teens learned that God uses difficult circumstances to strengthen our faith. Talk to your teen about what it means to step outside of your comfort zone and how obedience to God often requires this step. Remind your teen that no matter what the future holds, God has promised to provide what we need.
