Know: Christ served His disciples as an example of how they should serve one another.

Think: Understand that we should humble ourselves and serve others.

Do: Humble ourselves and serve others, no matter who they are.

Read—John 13:1-20

Serving others is not our first inclination. We are not servant-hearted by nature. A very important person humbled Himself to serve others and leave us an example to follow.

Worship — Praise to God.

Do—Walk With God

Option 1: Even though Jesus was Lord and Savior, He humbled Himself to the lowest of positions by washing His disciples' feet, which was the job of a servant. You can explain to your children that since people walked everywhere in Bible times and wore sandals, their feet were normally very dirty. This is why it was such a big deal that Jesus would choose to get on His knees and wash their feet. You can demonstrate your own humility by washing your child's feet and then encouraging your child to wash yours in return. You can also continue in your family service project in order to show your children how to put others before themselves.

Option 2: Ask your family to give examples of ways they have seen people serve others in significant ways. What were the circumstances? What was it about this service that stood out in their minds? How did the service help the one being served? What lessons could be learned from such examples of service?

Pray—Talk to God

We serve others no matter their failures, or how they treat us. Pray that you and your family would be able to love and serve those who do wrong against you.

Preschool

Today your child learned Jesus was praying when some people who didn't like Jesus took Him to jail. He was sent to a ruler named Pilate who sent Jesus to die on the cross. Even though He didn't do anything wrong, **Jesus Loves Me** so much He was willing to die so my sin would be forgiven.

Elementary

Today your student learned Jesus washed the disciples feet the night before His death. Even though He knew one of the disciples would betray Him, He demonstrated humility in His actions. He or she learned Jesus serves, and we should follow His example.

Youth

Teens examined what it means to live a life of humility and service. Discuss with your teen what it means to truly display humility as Christ did.
