Do-Walk With God

Option 1: Jesus died on the cross for our sins even though that meant He would have to be separated from God, which was against His nature. He didn't want to suffer, but He knew this was His Father's will. He was willing to sacrifice His own wants and His own life in order to do what God wanted Him to do. This will be the last week of your service project. Explain to your children that there are a lot of things they might rather be doing, but they are choosing to sacrifice those things in order to serve others, which is what God wants us to do.

This week in Sunday School...

Preschool

Today your child learned soldiers put nails in Jesus' hands and feet and hung Him to die on a cross. After His death, Jesus was placed in a tomb with a large stone over the opening. Soldiers were there to make sure no one took His body. Jesus died because He loves us. I know **Jesus Loves Me**.

Elementary

Today your student learned the Jewish leaders arrested Jesus and sentenced Him to death on a cross. Jesus willingly gave His life so we could have forgiveness of our sin. He or she learned Jesus gives so we can have eternal life.

Youth

Teens discussed the crucifixion and what it means for us and the whole world. Remind your teen of the debt sin brings and the high cost of salvation. Pray together and thank God for His grace and mercy displayed through the death of His Son.
