Know: Jesus rose from the dead and appeared to

His followers.

Think: Remember that we serve a risen Savior

#### Read—John 20:1-31

No event in human history has had more impact on the world than the resurrection of Jesus. Had there been a body in the tomb when the disciples arrived there, everything would be different. The Resurrection changes everything.

#### Do-Walk With God

Option 1: One of the things that makes Christianity unique is that we serve a living Savior. Explain to your child that the reason we celebrate Easter is because Jesus was not in the tomb when Mary Magdalene came to visit; the stone had been rolled away. To help your child see how heavy the rock was that was supposed to keep Jesus in the tomb, go on a field trip to find a big rock. This could be in your neighborhood, at a local park, or you might have to go to a hardware store to use a brick or stone. Have your child try to pick up or move the rock, and explain that no rock is too big for our God to move.

**Option 2:** Have your family act out the opening nine verses of John 20. Then discuss how it must have felt to be one of these followers of Jesus on Resurrection morning.

#### Pray—Talk to God

Jesus' resurrection changed fear to mission. Pray that you and your family will be able to move past your fears and share the gospel with the people God places in your lives.

# This week in Sunday School...

## **Preschool**

Today your child learned on the third day, two of Jesus' friends went to the tomb to put spices on His body. When they arrived, the stone was rolled back and Jesus' body was gone. An angel told them He was not there, and He is alive. I am so glad **Jesus Loves Me**, and He is risen!

## Elementary

Today your student learned after Jesus died, His body was placed in a tomb and a large stone was rolled in front of it. As two of His friends arrived to put spices on His body, they discovered the stone was rolled back and the tomb was empty. We celebrate Easter because Jesus lives.

#### Youth

Teens learned that the crucifixion was not the end of the story. Talk with your teens about ways to share this message of hope with those around them.
