March 6, 2016

Know: Christ moved people to faith through raising Lazarus from the dead.

Think: Recognize that we have eternal life through faith in Christ who has power over death.

Do: Lead the hurting to faith by showing compassion and proclaiming Christ as conqueror of death.

Read—John 11:1-44

There are lessons to learn from every story and event in the Bible. What lessons we can learn from Jesus raising a man from the dead? One lesson is that it is always worth waiting on God's timing.

Worship — Praise to God.

Do—Walk With God

Option 1: Jesus was a perfect man, however He is still able to understand our suffering. When Lazarus died, Jesus felt the pain that Mary and Martha were feeling. This is the only time we see Jesus crying in the Bible. In order for your child to more deeply understand the compassionate nature of God, over the next three weeks find a service project in which your family can get involved. This could be going to a nursing home, helping out in a soup kitchen, or helping your neighbor do some yard work. Any type of service project will help your child put him or herself in someone else's shoes, and allow him or her to be more compassionate like the Savior.

Option 2: Distribute slips of paper to your family. Ask each person to write the name of a favorite Bible story and one lesson that can be learned from it. For instance, consider the story of Abraham and Sarai. This story teaches us, among other things, that we are never too old for God to use. Collect the sheets of paper and share some of the stories with the rest of your family.

Pray—Talk to God

God may make us wait in order to grow our faith. Pray that you and your family would have patience in waiting for God's timing, instead of trying to form your own way.
