April 3, 2016

Know: God's names are an important way He reveals who He is and what He is like.

Think: Recognize that God is both powerful and personal. He is the only true God and reveals Himself as able to do whatever He intends to do.

Do: Learn as much as you can about God—who He is and what He is like.

Read Exodus 33:12—34:8.

Just as names are a significant part of our lives, names play a significant role for people in the Bible, and for God. We can learn about biblical characters, and about God, from their names.

Worship — Praise to God.

Do—Walk With God

Option 1: God is absolute and unchanging. God has always been, and He always will be. He is a merciful, but just God. Even though He is God, He still chooses to have a personal relationship with us. His presence is always with us, and He chooses to give us love and mercy. Talk with your child about the many different names of God, and how those names show us the different attributes of God. You can also take this time to explain the difference between Lord and LORD, two different names for God. Lord refers to His mastership and rule over us, while LORD refers to His being God, but still being loving and personable.

Option 2: Ask and briefly discuss the following with your family:

- Why you gave your children their names. (Is it a family name? Was it popular at the time they were born? Were they named for someone? Is it just a random name you liked? Did you deliberately choose an unusual or different name?)
- Share with them the particular meaning of their names. (Note: You can look up their meanings online at a website such as www.meaning-of-names.com. Be sure to use positive examples if you do this!)

Pray—Talk to God

Worship God as revealed by His names and seek to reflect His character. Pray that you and your family will be able to more deeply understand God through the study of His names, and that you will be a better reflection of Him because of it.

Preschool

Today your child learned **God Has Many Names**. He or she learned one of them is LORD. God appeared to Moses in a burning bush, and gave him a job to do. Moses learned God is always with us and is our helper.

Elementary

Your student learned one of the many names of God—*LORD*. God appeared to Moses on a mountain. He had Moses hide in the cleft of a rock as He passed by. God protected Moses with His hand, and moved it after He passed so Moses could see His glory. God also told Moses His special name, Yahweh, which signifies He is the one, true God.

Youth

Teens saw how the names of God describe different aspects of His character. Talk to your teen about what the names of God say about Him and how this should affect the way we view Him and even the way we live.
