Know: Job was humbled when he came to understand the magnitude of God. God accepted Job's confession and restored him.

Think: Understand that those who find God's restoration have an obligation to help others find it as well.

Memorize Do: Confess to God when you find yourself off track.

Read—Job 42.

Job and his friends both thought they were right, and argued their case. But God set them all straight!

Worship — Praise to God.

Do—Walk With God

Option 1: Job confessed that he was wrong in second guessing God's plan for him, and acknowledged that God was all powerful. Then, God restored Job's life to better than it was before. Explain to your child that even when times seem tough, we need to acknowledge God's power and know that He is leading us to a better life and a better version of ourselves. Scatter a puzzle on the ground and explain to your child that it represents Job's life. It was a mess and didn't make sense. Then help your child put the puzzle together. God helped Job put his life back together into something better than it was before.

Option 2: Ask your group members to share a time when they found out they were wrong about something they had claimed or argued about with others. Ask the following:

- What was the situation? What were you wrong about?
- How did it feel when you realized you were wrong?
- What was it like to admit to others (or to God) that you were wrong?

Pray—Talk to God

We should seek to reconcile and to restore broken relationships, and to forgive those who hurt us. Pray that you and your family would learn to love and forgive like God does. Even when we don't make the best choices, God forgives us and restores our relationship with Him.

This week in Sunday School...

Preschool

Today your child learned God reminded Job of how powerful and strong He is. He described to Job two animals He created. One was the Behemoth, a large and strong animal with a tail like a big tree. The other was the Leviathan, a powerful animal that lived in the sea. Job knew our powerful God Is With Us All the Time.

Elementary

Your student learned Job realized God could do anything and that even when we don't understand God's plan, we are to maintain our trust in Him. God blessed Job with twice as much as he had before. He or she can learn God will always do what is best for us, and we are to remain faithful to Him.

Youth

Teens learned that God can restore our relationship with Him and others when we humble ourselves before Him. Remind your teen that when life seems difficult and things happen that we don't understand, God is with us and may be trying to teach us something that will help us grow in our relationship with Him.
