Know: All Christians struggle with obedience to God.

Think: God has given us the Holy Spirit to help us win over sin.

Do: Listen to God's tug on your heart to obey Him.

Read—John 14:26; Romans 3:23; 5:8; 12; Hebrews 12:1; Galatians 5:16-23.

While living in a secular society can be difficult, the Holy Spirit will give us everything we need to live our lives for Christ in the midst of a secular culture.

Worship — Praise to God.

Trust and Obey —Hymn

Do—Walk With God

Option 1: This week your child learned what it means to live in the Spirit. As Christians, we face a constant struggle between doing what we want to do, and doing what God wants us to do. Remind your child that if he focuses on practicing the fruit of the Spirit in his life, he will better be able to live in the Spirit and glorify God in his actions. Have your child gather multiple types of fruit, and help him make a fruit salad. Explain to him that it takes all of the fruit to make the salad, and in the same way, it takes all of the fruit of the Spirit to fully live in the Spirit.

Option 2: Share this with your family and then discuss the questions that follow: *America was settled by people who were seeking to escape a growing secularism (Pilgrims). They wanted to worship in their own way. Others, instead of leaving their country, decided to stay home in England to seek to reform the situation there (Puritans). What do you see as the benefits and negatives of both positions? If you were faced with the situation of leaving or staying to reform, which do you think you would attempt? Why?*

Pray—Talk to God

Live for God in your culture, depending on the Spirit for power and guidance. Pray that you and your family would be able to rely on the Spirit to live out God's commands even when it's not popular.

This week in Sunday School...

Preschool

Today your child learned God promised Abram that his family would be as many as the stars in the sky. Even though Abram and his wife, Sarai, were old and did not have any children, Abram believed because he knew God Keeps His Promises and nothing was too powerful for Him.

Elementary

Today your student learned because of Adam and Eve's disobedience we are born with a desire to sin (anything we think, say, or do that goes against God's ways). He or she learned all Christians struggle with obedience to God, but He has given us the Holy Spirit to help us win over sin. Your student learned each person must make the choice to say *yes* to God and say *no* to sin.

Youth

Teens examined what it means to live according to the Spirit's guidance and power. Discuss with your teen ways to live for God in our culture through the power of the Spirit.
