



# Weekly Family Worship

June 19, 2016

**Know:** God loves all people, does not have favorites, and values people.

**Think:** We are to use the rules of respect in our everyday lives to show God's love to others.

**Do:** Look for ways to follow God's example and show respect for all people.

**Read—John 13:34 Acts 10:1-44; Deuteronomy 10:17; Psalm 139:14.**

God does not play favorites. Every person has equal access to God through salvation by grace through faith. God invites people to Himself as they are, without having to become like me first.

**Worship — Praise to God.**

**Do—Walk With God**

**Option 1:** This week your child learned that God does not have favorites. God loves and accepts any person who chooses to do what is right, no matter his or her ethnicity. Remind your child that we are not the same as God, but He still chose to accept us, therefore we should treat everyone in the same way. Give your child an assortment of M&M's of different colors. Have him or her only pick out the green ones because, "They are the best!" Then have your child taste the green ones and all of the other colors. Explain to him or her that even though the M&M's all look different on the outside, they are all the same on the inside. That is how God sees us.

**Option 2:** Ask if any in your family have ever been discriminated against, or have seen this happen to someone else, for something they had no control over—their ethnicity, their language, their religious background, etc. How did they respond to the discrimination?

**Pray—Talk to God**

God does not play favorites. His offer of grace is without restrictions. Pray that you and your family would see the world through God's eyes, looking at the heart instead of the outward appearance.

### Preschool
