Know: God's Word helps us learn how to deal with difficult people.

Think: Following God's instructions will guide us in the best way to live.

Do: Look for ways to show kindness and love to others even when it is hard.

Read—Matthew 5:43-45; 18:15-17; Romans 12:17-21; Ephesians 4:29-32.

Some people just cause us problems. We are going to look at some of what the Bible says about loving and dealing with problem people.

Do—Walk With God

Option 1: This week your children learned the importance of loving your enemy. God taught us to feed our enemy when he is hungry, which shows that we are always to do what is right, even if it is toward someone we do not like. Remind your children that it is not their job to punish or correct someone else's behavior; that is God's job. Have your children talk with you about someone at school who doesn't always make the best choices. Remind your child that instead of judging them, we are to love them and be their friend. The best way to help them is to be an example through your own good choices. Have them try and list examples of some good choices they could make.

Option 2: Ask your family to vaguely (no names please) describe "problem people" they have known (excluding anyone in the room or at the church that others might recognize). Why was/is this person a problem person? What is it about the person that makes it so difficult to deal with them? What does the Bible say about how we are to deal with problem people?

Pray—Talk to God

Take time to encourage and help those who are hurting. Pray that you and your family will be sensitive to the needs of others and have a Christlike attitude when dealing with them.

Preschool

Elementary

He or she learned the Bible guides us on how to live in this world and four ways in which God's Word can help us.

Youth

Teens learned to look at "problem people" through the lens of the gospel. Talk with your teens about ways to respond when they are not treated well or fairly.
