



Weekly Family Worship

October 16, 2016

Know: God struck down the firstborn of Egypt but passed over the Israelites. The yearly Passover celebration was instituted.

Think: Abide in the confidence that Christ's blood covers your sin and protects you.

Do: Trust in Christ, the Passover Lamb, whose shed blood washes away your sin!

Read— Exodus 12:1-42

Of all that can be celebrated in our lives, nothing is any more meaningful or special than forgiveness. But this forgiveness comes at a cost. God's people learned this in Exodus 12. They would never look at blood, or forgiveness, the same again.

Worship — Praise to God.

Do—Walk With God

Option 1: God delivered the Israelites from the final plague, the death of firstborn sons, and from the Egyptians by helping them escape. They had to trust that God would guide and protect them, even when it looked impossible to do. Try this fun activity to practice things that seem impossible: Get two cartons of eggs. Make sure none of the eggs are broken and that they are all facing the same direction (pointy side up or down). Have your children take off their socks and, one at a time, carefully step up onto the eggs, distributing their weight evenly. You might want to lay a trash bag underneath the cartons in case it doesn't go as planned! Talk about how not everything that seems impossible really is, especially with God in charge!

Option 2: Play a word association game with your family. Say the following words aloud and ask them to respond with the first thing that comes to their mind. Feel free to add your own words as well.

• Chocolate • Friends • Bucket • Brain • Blood

After spending a few minutes on this exercise, discuss with your family any responses that were surprising. What surprised you about these? If someone responded to "blood" with forgiveness or Passover, ask why. If no one responded in this way, ask why we don't typically think of forgiveness when blood is mentioned, especially when it's such a central theme of Scripture.

Pray—Talk to God

Trust in Christ for salvation and praise Him for shedding His blood to cover our sins. Pray that you and your family will learn to completely trust in God's promise of salvation, and continually thank Him for the forgiveness that He offers.

Preschool
