Know: From birth, God was training Moses to be the deliverer of the Israelites from Egypt.

Think: Be conscious of God's intentional leading and presence in your life.

Do: Use what you have learned and experienced to serve the Lord as He leads you.

Read— Exodus 2:1-25

Regardless of the career or position, training is vital. Whether that training is in the classroom or with on-the-job experience, the time spent in preparation is invaluable. Like career training, the Lord often has His own training program He puts His followers through. Such is the case with Moses.

Worship — Praise to God.

Do—Walk With God

Option 1: Moses grew up as an Egyptian although he knew that the Israelites were really his people. As he grew older, Moses developed a heart for his true people and wanted to deliver them from their slavery. Explain to your child that God had a special plan for Moses, and all the events in his life made him into the person God would use. Talk with your child about how God has made him or her unique. Discuss the things your child enjoys doing or is good at. Help him or her come up with some ways God can use his or her skills and characteristics.

Option 2: Take a few minutes and ask your family members to share what their dream career is and what the training for that career looks like. For instance, if the career is in the medical profession, it might take 8-10 years of college and graduate studies, two years of internships, and another year as an apprentice.

Pray—Talk to God

God uses all of our life circumstances to grow and prepare us for His will. Pray that you and your family would be open for all that God has in store for you. Pray that your family will remember that everything happens for a reason.

Teens saw that God, according to His plan, used the events of Moses' life to prepare him to be the deliverer of His people. Talk to your teen about ways God has prepared you through circumstances in your life and how He may be doing that in your teen's life right now as well.
