**Know:** God parted the sea to deliver the children of Israel from the armies of Egypt.

**Think:** Be at peace with the assurance that God is in control and will accomplish His plan.

**Do:** Fight the urge to doubt God when faced with difficulty and uncertainty. Trust Him to see you through the situation.

## Do—Walk With God

**Option 1:** God was leading the Israelites out of Egypt, but Pharaoh changed his mind and started to go after them. God helped Moses create a dry path in the Red Sea for God's people to walk on, but when they were all across God made the walls of water fall onto the Egyptians. God used His power to protect His people. To demonstrate how God's power can protect us, have your child fill a glass with water. Then place a playing card over the top of the glass covering the entire hole. Put the cup over your child's head and turn it over. The card should suction to the glass and none of the water will fall onto your child.

**Option 2:** Play a simple game of "Possible or Impossible." (Note: some surveys may differ on the responses listed here. Allow this to generate some fun and arouse curiosity but don't get too hung up on the answers.)

- Tickle yourself (Impossible)
- Travel exceeding the speed of light (Impossible)
- Climb to the top of Mt. Everest (Possible)
- Human being to free-fall from space (120,000 feet up) and live (Possible)
- Licking the tip of your own elbow (Impossible)

## Pray—Talk to God
