November 20, 2016

Read Know: Prayer is an amazing God-given privilege that we should exercise often.

Think: God hears our prayers.

Do: Follow the biblical guidelines for prayer and make it a priority in Christian living.

Read— **Matthew 7:7-11; 21:22; John 14:13-14; Romans 8:26-27; 2 Corinthians 12:7-10; Ephesians 6:18; 1 John 3:21-22; Jude 1:20.** In one sense, prayer is simple, yet it can seem complex. Prayer is easy enough for a child, but it can be exceedingly difficult at times. Prayer is mysterious and otherworldly, but it is also concrete and down-to-earth. God invites us to come to Him in prayer.

Worship — Praise to God.

Do—Walk With God

Option 1: Prayer is an important part of a relationship with God. It is how we talk to Him. Use the acronym ACTS (Adore, Confess, Thank, Supply) to help you and your child pray in a more balanced way. Your conversations with God should have all these elements—times when you tell God how wonderful and mighty He is and a way you saw that in action; times when you tell Him about sin you are struggling with; times when you thank Him for blessing you or teaching you something in some way; and times when you ask Him to supply you with what you need to be more like Him, or to meet a need you see. Have a discussion about what God's glory is, and remind your child that prayer should always be about bringing God glory.

Option 2: Use these questions to get your family talking about prayer.

- What is the craziest thing you have ever asked God to do for you? (Give you answers to a test for which you had not studied; make a particular person fall in love with you; enable you to win a game, contest, or sweepstakes, etc.)
- What is one instance in which you prayed for something in particular but God seemed to give you something different? (Share your own example here.)
- In retrospect, can you see how His way was better or are you still struggling to see it that way? (Sometimes we can readily see how God's way was better; other times we have to trust Him in faith believing that we'll understand some day, here or in eternity.)

Pray—Talk to God

God has given us specific practical instruction regarding how to pray and receive answers to our prayers. Pray that you and your family will be able to learn more about the purpose of prayer and how to look for God's answers.

Preschool

Teens examined the topic of prayer. Discuss the importance of prayer with your teens, and put it into practice regularly. Make sure they know they can count on you to pray with them and for them.
