



## Weekly Family Worship November 27, 2016

**Know:** Heaven is a real place and God is in Heaven.

**Think:** God gave His Son so those who believe in Him would spend eternity in Heaven.

**Do:** Share what you learned about Heaven with those around you.

### **Read— Revelation 21:1—22:5; Genesis 1:26-30; 2:15-25.**

Life in this world has a way of lowering our expectations for how good things can be or how any lasting satisfaction can be found. While most of us realize that Heaven won't just involve standing around in white robes singing forever, what it actually involves might seem so foreign that we don't bother giving it much thought in our daily lives. Scripture paints a picture of Heaven that is not only worthy of longing for, but also can enrich our joy here and now.

### **Worship — Praise to God.**

### **Do—Walk With God**

**Option 1:** Heaven is a place where God is making a home for His people. God will be there with us. He will wipe away our tears, there will be no death, there will be no sadness, and there will be no pain. It does not need a sun or a moon because God's glory is its light, and there will be no night. Before discussing Heaven with your children, have them draw a picture of what they think Heaven will be like. Then, after discussing it with them, talk about the differences between what they thought and how it will really be. You can even encourage them to draw another picture based on their new understanding.

**Option 2:** Ask the following questions:

- What is the best Christmas gift you ever received?
- Can you remember what you received for Christmas last year?
- How many of you still use those items regularly?

### **Pray—Talk to God**

Worship God by striving to be a pure dwelling place for His glory. Pray that you and your family would live lives worthy of the presence of God. Pray that you will live lives that will show the world His glory.

### **Preschool**

Today your child learned before He went to Heaven, Jesus gave His disciples a job. He told them to go and tell everyone about Him. He wants us to do that too. We are to tell others Jesus died and rose again so we could go to Heaven. **Heaven Is Our Home.**

### **Elementary**

Today your student learned what the Bible tells us about Heaven. God is in Heaven, and John described Heaven in Revelation 21. He or she learned Heaven is a real place, and Jesus is the only way to get to Heaven. One day, Jesus will return to take us to Heaven. Until then, we are to tell others about Heaven and how to spend eternity there.

### **Youth**

Teens explored what the Bible teaches about Heaven. Explore this topic further with your teen, making sure to check the things you find in popular culture about Heaven against what the Bible says.
