



Weekly Family Worship

November 6, 2016

- Know:** God created angels to serve as His messengers and to worship Him.
- Think:** Live in the awareness that we are in the presence and protection of God's messengers.
- Do:** Follow the example of the angels in faithful service and worship of God.

Read— Read **Colossians 1:16-17; Revelation 22:8-9; Matthew 26:53; Hebrews 13:2**. Interest in angels and “spiritual” beings has risen over the last decade. There are a lot of different ideas about angels and their work in our world. However, the only valid and reliable source of understanding about angels comes from the Bible.

Worship — Praise to God.

Do—Walk With God

Option 1: Some people in the Bible mistook angels for God and tried to worship them, but angels were created to worship and serve Him. Many people have stories about how they have seen angels, and the Bible even says that we should not ignore strangers because they could be angels. Remind your child that God also sends His angels to protect us. Go on a bike ride with your child and talk about how his helmet protects him if he falls. Explain that in the same way, angels protect us when we fall into temptation, if we will let them. Discuss the other forms of protection that we use every day, like seat belts or shin guards.

Option 2: Find a picture or a figurine of an angel. Take time to discuss our perception

or features that are usually common to our understanding of angels. Ask:

- Do you think all angels have wings?
- Why do we think of angels as naked babies with harps?
- Where do you think we get our perception of angels?

Pray—Talk to God

Worship is directed only to God and not to any aspect of His creation. Pray that you and your family will focus your worship and praise on God alone, even when it is easy to be distracted by the things around us.

Preschool

Youth

Teens discussed what the Bible teaches about angels and what it has to do with us today. Discuss this topic with your teen, reminding him or her that angels are real and have a specific role in God's plan, but that God alone is to be worshiped.
